Hamilton-Gibson’s 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Shaw Festival Day Trip

Saturday, May 5th, 2018

Participants in Hamilton-Gibson’s 14th annual theatre day trip to Niagara-on-the-Lake will get to see this lively song-and-dance comedy in the Shaw Festival’s flagship 856-seat Festival Theatre.

The one-day theatre trip to the Shaw Festival in Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario, on May 5th is part of Hamilton-Gibson’s ongoing educational and cultural outreach mission. It’s not too soon to reserve your seat on the bus. Transportation for this outing will be provided by Benedict’s Bus Service, departing from the terminal in Whitneyville at 6:30 a.m. and returning before 10 p.m. (Other boarding sites are available en route to Canada.)

Spending a Saturday afternoon with Hamilton-Gibson in the “loveliest town in Ontario” does a good job of inspiring Twin Tiers residents to begin “thinking spring.” Besides seeing a stunning professional theatrical production, visitors to Niagara-on-the-Lake can enjoy other features of this historic Canadian village. Situated at the mouth of the Niagara River, the town is known for its floral parks and walkways, period homes, and fine shops and restaurants. The region also attracts International visitors interested in golfing, sailing, and discovering the many wineries.

By taking advantage of group rates, we are able to keep the cost reasonably low and less than half the cost of a single ticket alone. The cost of this year’s trip is a bargain at \$135 per person. This price includes hearing devices for those who request them. Meals are not included. **All participants must carry valid passports.**

The Shaw Festival Day Trip is open to adults and to children accompanied by adult. Space is limited to 40 persons. Although immediate full payment is recommended, reservations (\$50 deposit per person) will be accepted on a first-come basis, with the balance due by March 16th, 2018. If fewer than 20 persons sign up, full refunds will be made.
